

Basic House Cleaning Checklist

Kitchen

- Sink, start with the sink! (www.flylady.com)
- Counters (Wipe them down and move the items on your counter and wipe under them too!)
- Floor—Sweep, vacuum or get the dirt off your favorite way!
- Wipe down fronts of cabinets and drawers
- Wash floor (I prefer by hand, but a trusty mop works well too.)

Bathroom

- Sweep the floor (I like to sweep the floor first to avoid any water splash while cleaning.)
- Clean the Toilet (Make sure to clean the tank and the base of the toilet too.)
- Counters (Just like the kitchen, pick up anything sitting on the counters and clean under them)
- Sinks
- Shower/tub
- Clean Mirrors and shower doors
- Wash floor

Dining Room/Table area

- Wipe down table top, and legs too
- Dust off chairs and wash off any fingerprints, spills, etc.
- Dust off light fixture above table
- Vacuum, Dust Mop or wash floor

Family Room/Living Areas

- Dust everything (Make sure to not only dust the surfaces, but the knick knacks, electronics, etc.)
- Dust off baseboards and windowsills
- Vacuum carpet or dust mop hardwood floors
- Vacuum any area rugs

Bedrooms

- Dust everything
- Dust off baseboards and windowsills
- Vacuum carpet or Dust mop hardwood floors
- Clean mirrors
- Dust off fans or light fixtures

Stairs

- Dust or vacuum stairs
- Wipe down banister and railing
- Clean any fingerprints on wall
- Don't forget to dust the light fixture above the stairs too
